A WORD FROM PASTOR BO BAUMEISTER

Brothers and sisters in Christ,

"Change or die" is a stark and startling phrase that may seem out of place at church, but, I would contend that in Jesus' ministry, this appeal was imbedded in what Jesus said and did. In Matthew 18:3 he said, "Truly I tell you, unless you change and become like little children, you will never enter the kingdom of heaven." (NIV) Those observing Jesus' healings exclaimed, "What is this? A new teaching—and with authority!" (Mark 1:27)

When Jesus called the twelve to follow him, it meant that they would have to totally change the direction of their lives. The very act of repentance calls for people to change direction away from sin and toward Christ. "Change or die" is entrenched in the Christian life.

Anytime a new pastor begins ministry at a congregation, there are changes. Ideally, these changes are good and beneficial for the life of the church, but change is difficult until it becomes common.

I will tell you straight up that any changes that come for St. John are intended to extend the lifespan and effectiveness of the ministry God has given to us here. Some changes are mundane, like the format of the newsletter. Some changes are more significant like the content and flow of worship services. And some are crucial for fulfilling Jesus' command, "**You** will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." (Acts 1:8)

Throughout my ministry I've worked to encourage, equip, and engage more people in the ministry of the congregation. If you are a member here, this means you. Right here I am calling on you to be open to how the Lord might be calling you to serve in new or different ways. If attending worship is the extent of how you follow Jesus, it's time for a change.

Always know that you can ask me anything, discuss important issues with me, disagree with me or even consider becoming a Nebraska Cornhusker fan. I'm sure that Jesus would approve! (That part is a joke.)
